- 2. Sue Kemnitzer tags 67, 68, 69 & 70 in back alley behind her house UPDATE Bartlett was reached out to; Derek will come on his own time to cut the vines. Need decide if these are town trees.

- 3. Monarch Way Station at Rumsey–replace boulders for a possible garden design? If so, who does this? The Milkweed area still needs weeding. Asters needs be trimmed to 18".
- 4. Rumsey Monument Park Decide which oak tree to plant -- a large White Oak (red foliage in the fall) or a Chinquapin Oak? (Or piece of ironworks with drought resistant plants around it) Question would Parks and Recreation Committee take care of clearing the bowl and tending to surrounding area? Or do we need take this on? Watering plan?

- 6. James Butcher 216 W. German Street requested tree replacement for removed tree. Any decisions needed on curb replacement prior to tree planting? Need cut new tree well? Replacement tree species?

- 8. Dave McMillion 206 W. High St #157 trimming requested; quote requested (from who?) status unknown
- 9. Corner of Church and High Streets by the old Stella home on the left side of Church St. Hard to pull out. Commission approved tree trimming on left side of Church St.- status unknown
- 10. Market House Crabapple thin, cut water sprouts, growth retardant quote requested from Derek/Bartlett? status unknown
